

Bonner Vows Attempt to Repeal Health Care Reform

(CHICKASAW, Ala.) - Alabama Congressman Jo Bonner is vowing that Republicans will try to repeal health care reform if they win enough seats in November elections.

While attending the groundbreaking for a new emergency shelter in Chickasaw Monday, Bonner said health care reform, as it was passed last week, is clearly not what the American people want.

"It's as though Speaker Pelosi and the President and others have just stuck their fingers in their eyes and just told the American people 'We're not listening to you,'" Bonner said.

Alabama, Florida and eleven other states are suing U.S. government agencies over health care reform, arguing that it's unconstitutional.
